

The first cooperation agreement signed by the WIPO Academy was with an African partner: University of South Africa, in 1999




Total Number of participants, 2012 - 2015






About 50 Government officials from Africa are offered complimentary advanced training courses in IP every year in different parts of the world.



Primer and general courses are free of charge.




- Standard administration fees are applied to advanced courses.

- The WIPO Academy does not charge for tuition fees.




Distance-Learning Program Total Number of Participants, 2012-2015




Academic Institutions Program Participation modalities




Academic Institutions Program Geographical Distribution of Participants in the Joint Master's Program, 2012 - 2015


WIPO Summer Schools Participation modalities

The WIPO-South Africa Summer School on IP and Transfer of Technology is regularly organized with the assistance of the Government of Japan. A limited number of scholarships are offered


