Context: Knowledge gap

- Study conducted by WHO in 2003:
 - Countries with a GNP less than US\$1,000 : 56% of medical institutions had no subscriptions over the previous 5 years.
 - Countries with GNP between US\$1,000 US\$3,000 : 34% of medical institutions had an average of two subscriptions per year.


TISC Services

> 700'000 inquiries supported annually (data as of December 2017)




Regional distribution



WIPO-WEF Inventor Assistance Program (IAP)

- Legal assistance in filing and prosecution of patent applications for under-resourced inventors and small enterprises
- Pilot projects in Colombia, Morocco, and Philippines in 2015/16
- Global launch October 17, 2016
- Program launch in Ecuador and South Africa in 2017

WIPO


- Matches inventor with advisors

Project on Patents and the Public Domain

- Practical guides on the identification and use of inventions in the public domain
 - Piloting and fine-tuning of guides
- New and enhanced training materials based on the guides for use/promotion by TISCs
- Roster of experts in different regions on identification and use of inventions in the public domain
- Improved legal status portal



Project on Technology Transfer Training

- Provide appropriate training for specific key role players in innovation value chain
 - Funders, developers, managers, users
- Methodology and Toolkit for training needs assessment in area of tech transfer/commercialization
- Mapping innovation value chain particularly role of key players in specific pilot countries
- Assessing training needs for the key role players using the methodology and toolkit
- Establishing training plans in pilot countries followed by general roll-out


