

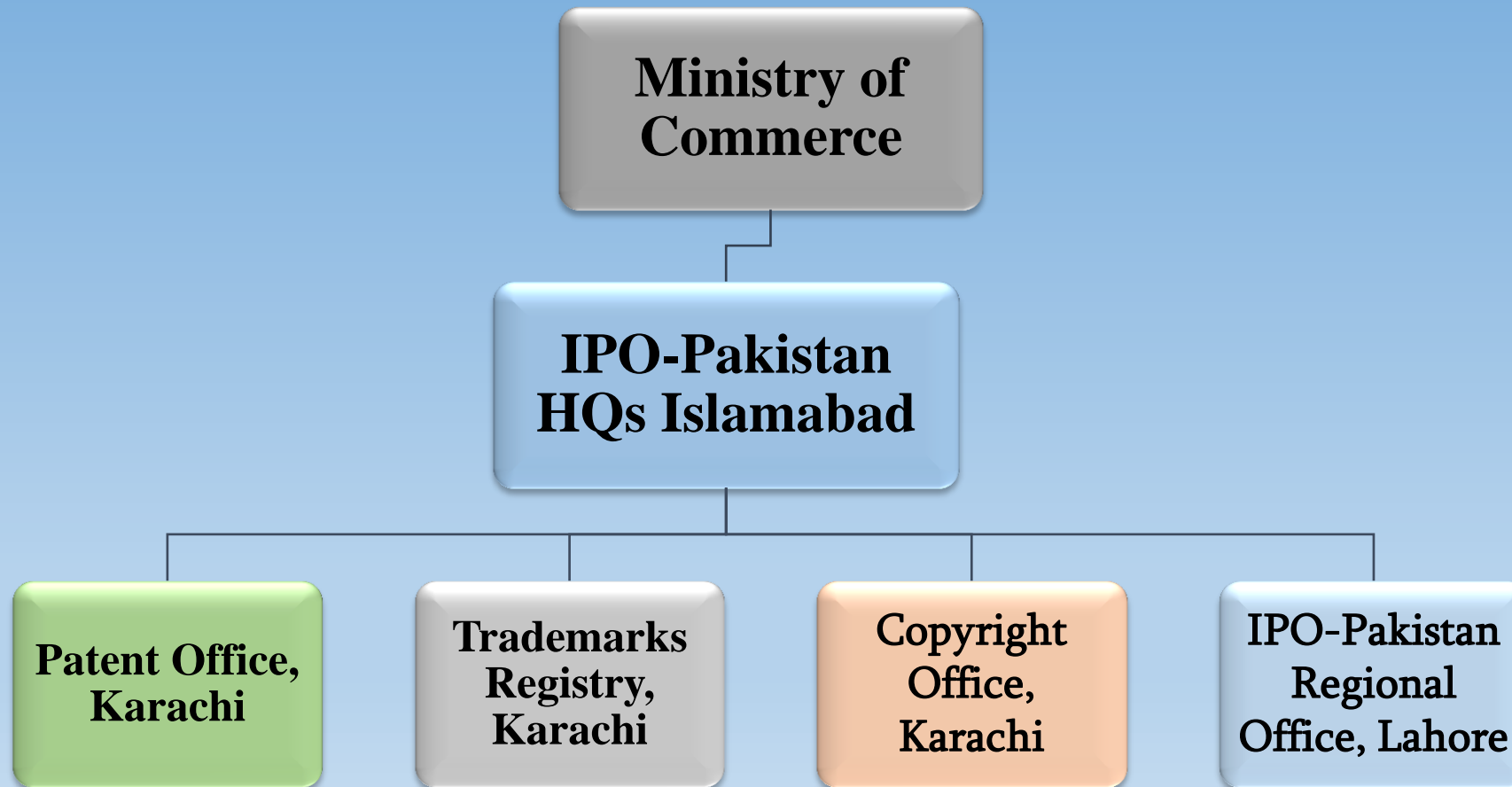

IPO Policy Board

- **14 Members:**
 - **5 Federal Government Members (*Ex-officio*)**
 - **4 Provincial Government Members**
 - **5 Private Sector Members**

*** Major Functions of IPO-Pakistan**

- **Advise the Federal Government on Intellectual Property Rights (IPRs) related issues**
- **Administration of Intellectual Property Rights laws**
- **Management and supervision of all Intellectual Property Rights Offices established under National IP Laws**
- **Coordination with the designated government agencies for the enforcement of IPRs**
- **Coordination & collaboration with relevant national & international organizations**
- **Promotion of IP awareness in the country**

- Encouraging R&D by bridging the gap between academia and industry
- Establishment of discussion forum to address issues related to new technologies and Global IP system
