
CAMBODIAN CURRENT STATUS AND FUTURE PERSPECTIVES ON IP EDUCATION

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Current Status of IP Education IP Public Awareness and Education has been conducted, but not widespread

- Around 300 people participated in seminars/workshops (government officials and right holder)
- Around 250 students take IP course (elective subject, 3 universities)
- Around 350 public (IP day and others dissemination)
- No standard curriculum and proper trainer
- No proper training unit at IPO
- Contend (Trademark, Patent, and Copyrights)

Response to the Challenge:

Strengthen, Enforce and Disseminate IP

National Committee for IPR (NCIPR):

was established by <u>Sub-Decree</u> of the Prime Minister No. 142 on September 18, 2008 with 14 Ministries

1- Minister of Commerce : Chairman

• Department of Intellectual Property Rights (D/IPR): Secretariat

2- Ministry of Industry : Deputy

3- Ministry of Cultural : Deputy

4- Office of Council of Ministers: Member

5- Min. Interior (Police) : Member

6- Min. Finance (Custom) : Member

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7- Min. Information : Member

8- Min. Telecommunication : Member

9- Min. Health : Member

10- Min. Agriculture : Member

11- Min. Environment : Member

12- Min. Justice : Member

13- Min. Education : Member

14- Min. Tourism : Member

Purposes of Establishment of the NCIPR

- 1- Stimulate and assure a unique national policy on IP
- 2- Enhance a smooth cooperation between ministries and institutions concerned in preparing, <u>disseminating</u>, and enforcing IP laws and regulations
- 3- <u>Comply</u> with the commitment of Cambodia during its accession to <u>WTO</u>
- 4- Receive and <u>utilize effectively technical assistance</u> related to IP from international organization and other countries

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Future Plan of IP Education

- Sub-Committee on IP Education and Dissemination under the National Committee for IPR
- Assess existing resources and needs for IP education and teaching material
- Design a training/Educational manual (in Khmer language)
- train-the-trainer
- Proper curriculum
- Compulsory course (law → business)
- Set up IP training center/IP Academy
