

1.1 Decision of international patent application

uIs it necessary to file patent applications abroad?

üMarket and potential market

üTechnical and commercial values of invention

üLife cycle of the invention technology

üAssessment of costs and benefits



1.1 Decision of international patent application

UPCT route or Paris Convention route?

ÜInvention or appearance design

PCT system does not apply to appearance design, so Paris Convention route can be chosen for appearance design

üWhat countries and regions want to enter

For cost reason, we propose to choose Paris Convention route If we want to enter less than 3 countries, and to choose PCT route if we want to enter 3 or more

üTime to file national application

If you want to file a national application as soon as possible, you can choose Paris Convention route, if you want to postpone filing national application, you can choose the PCT route



1.2 Decision of the international phase

uFile domestic application first or PCT application first?

ÜBenefits of filing domestic application first

ØYou can postpone protection period for one year, because most countries' patent protection period starts from the date of filing (PCT filing date), rather than the priority date

ØYou can amend the application before filing PCT application by including some newly improved features and examples

üBenefits of filing PCT application first

ØYou can complete applications for all PCT contracting states in one time with one application, including the domestic application

ØYou will receive International Search Report at an earlier date (9 months from the filing date), and go through the international preliminary examination in advance



1.2 Decision of the international phase

■ Whether to request for the international preliminary examination?

ÜThe cost of the international preliminary examination (in China, application fee CHF 200, examination fee CNY 1500)

ÜFurther understanding the examiner's opinion through the international preliminary examination

ÜInternational Preliminary Report on Patentability will not influence the examination in national phase

ÜWe propose that you decide weather to start the international preliminary examination procedure **after receiving the International Search Report**



1.3 Decision of national phase entry

Whether to enter the national phase?

üCarry out patentability assessment of the PCT application according to the International Search Report, the Written Opinion of the International Searching Authority and possible International Preliminary Report on Patentability

UWhen to enter the national phase?

üEnter at the expiration of 30 months from priority date?

Delay payment of the cost in national phase

üEnter at 16 months from the priority date (receiving International Search Report and Written Opinion)?

Consideration on litigation, investment and licensing negotiations



1.3 Decision of national phase entry

uWhich countries to enter in national phase?

üCorporate patent strategy

üCurrent major markets and potential market

üCompetitor's location and their major markets

üRelevant countries' economic and technological development level

üRelevant countries' intellectual property protecting environment


üCosts (official fee and agent fee)



1.4 SANY practice

uEach business division of SANY has a patent committee, which consisted of management, technical experts and patent experts, who make decisions on patent matters

Meetings for filing foreign patent application are held every quarter. In the meeting, international application filing assessment should be made for domestic applications within the priority period, and PCT national phase entry assessment should be made for PCT applications of 18-25 months from the priority date.

1.4 SANY practice

■Foreign application filing assessment

üDecide whether to file foreign application

üDecide file application with PCT route or Paris Convention route

üNot decide which country to enter

üMainly consider technical factors, market and other factors

uPCT national phase entry assessment


ÜDecide whether to enter the national phase as well as which countries to enter

üBefore the meeting, inventors and patent engineers will carefully review the

Written Opinion of the International Searching Authority, and express opinions on the patentability as reference to the committee

üMainly consider patentability, market competition, patent strategy and other factors







2.1 Submit by yourself

uChina's State Intellectual Property Office (SIPO) allows applicants to submit their PCT applications by their own (not via the agency)

uPCT application contents generally have little change compared to its domestic applications claimed for priority

Using a local agent for the domestic application, then submit PCT application by yourself within the priority period, thus saving the agency fee in the international phase

u It's available for companies with strong patent teams



2.2 Fee reduction

uCost reduction for electronic filing through PCT-SAFE software

üEASY mode, reduction of 100 CFH

üFully electronic mode in PDF format, reduction of 200 CHF

üFully electronic mode in XML format, reduction of 300 CHF

ÜWhen selecting the agency, it is required to submit the PCT application through PCT-SAFE

ÜWhen companies submit PCT applications by their own, PCT-SAFE shall be used



2.3 Page control of application documents

UOn the filing day, try to control the PCT application documents within 30 sheets to avoid additional fee

üFive kinds of declaration can be submitted after filing of the PCT application, no later than the 16 months from the priority date

ÜWhen signing the application with PCT-SAFE, it can be signed by only one applicant/agent, to reduce the pages of application documents

üCo-applicants can be added within 30 months from the date of priority

ÜBased on the formatting requirement of the international publication, the pages of descriptions, claims and drawings can be reduced through adjusting the layout




2.4 Avoid paying late fee

uPayment of transmittal fee, international filing fee, search fee shall be made within 1 month after the office receive PCT applications.

■A surcharge shall be paid if the payment isn't made before the deadline

UIf the full amount of the payment (including the late fee) is not made before the deadline set by the office, the application will be considered withdrawn







■Amend when receiving International Search Report

ÜAgree with the Written Opinion of the International Searching Authority

ÜAmend claims according to searched references and the written opinion

üThe effect of the amendment in international phase : effect of temporary protection

ÜWithin 16 months from the priority date or within two months from the date of sending International Search Report, the claims can be amended once



UAmendment in international preliminary examination phase

ÜLearn more about the examiner's opinion through document amendment or statement of opinions

üIt's available to amend the claims, description, and drawings

ÜObtain a favorable International Preliminary Report in the international phase, to reduce the number of office action in the national phase, thus reduce agency cost and speed up the examination progress

ÜAmend when submitting a demand of the preliminary examination or before preparing preliminary examination report



■Amend when entering national phase

ÜAgree with the written opinion of the International Searching Authority

ÜRe-write the claims according to the searched references and the written opinion

ÜReduce the number of office action in the national phase

ÜRemove the claims unable to enhance the patentability according to the written opinion to avoid additional fee in case of the number of claims exceeds certain amount prescribed by the receiving office in the national phase



■Not amend when entering national phase or before

üMay obtain broader protection scope

üEach national application may need to be amended in the examination stage in the national phase

ÜMay need to respond to more office actions in the national phase, and result in more cost



3.2 Change of the Index


UChange applicant, applicant address, inventor and so on

UChanges in the international phase take effect for all PCT contracting states

UThe change procedure is simple in the international phase, generally it is not required to submit proof of change, and there is no need for additional cost

uChanges in the national phase need change in each country, which are cumbersome and costly






