New functionalities since IPC/CE/46:

- web service
- Evolutions for IPCRMS: Get XML fragment web service for CPC-based or FI-based IPC revision proposals



IPC publication platform (IPCPUB)

Changes:

- Illustrations integrated in IPC definitions
- Modifications due to CPC format change in April 2015 (order and 2000 series)
- New web service to receive in IPC-like XML either the CPC or FI fragment below a given IPC symbol




IPCPUB perspectives

Planned for Q2 2016: IPCPUB 7

- New user interface with responsive design to support a broader range of devices (e.g. tablet)
- Smart search for public users integrating a cascade of search feature (e.g. STATS, IPCCAT,...)
- Tree view
- definition integrated in scheme tab
- PDF version at Section and Class level

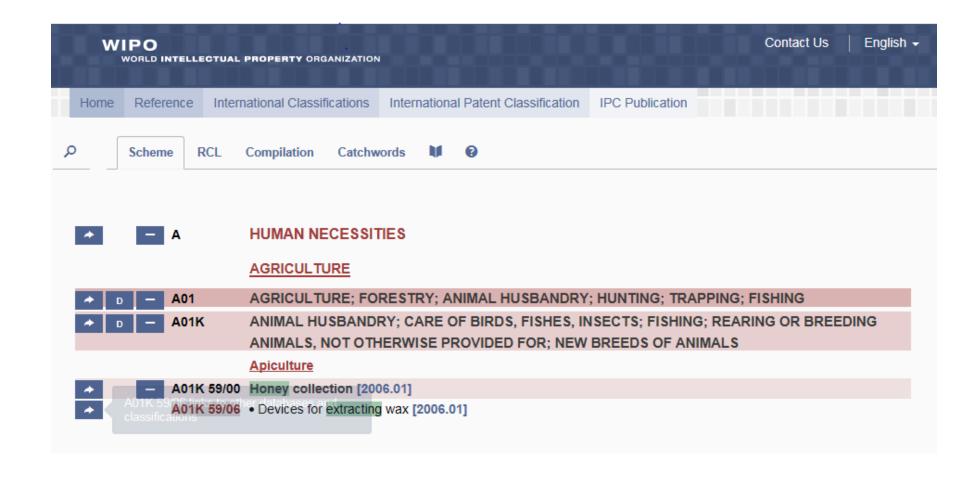


IPCPUB 7 on desktop for novice user



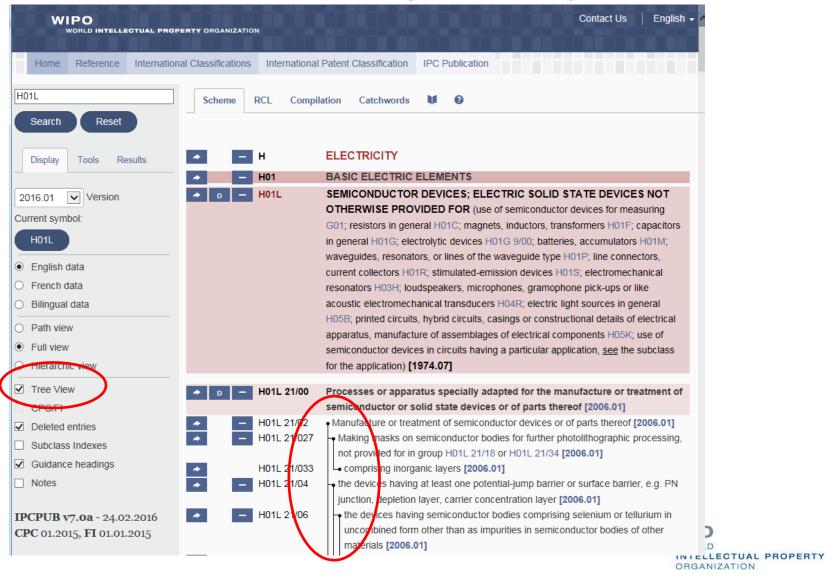


IPCPUB 7 on tablet

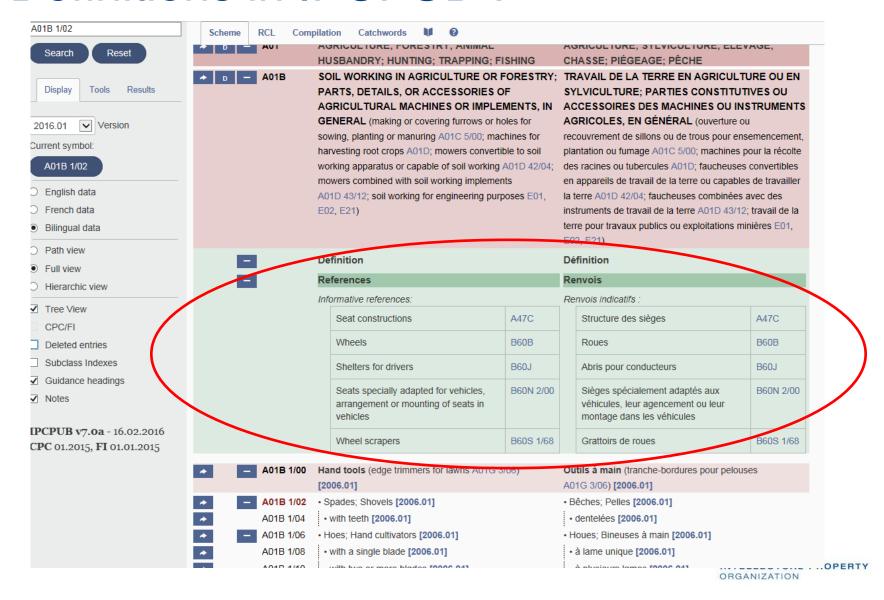




IPCPUB 7 on desktop for expert user
