FINAL ACT

adopted by the Diplomatic Conference on July 2, 1999

In accordance with the decisions by the Assemblies of the World Intellectual Property Organization (WIPO) taken at their thirty-second series of meetings (March 1998) and following preparations carried out by WIPO, the Diplomatic Conference for the Adoption of a New Act of the Hague Agreement Concerning the International Deposit of Industrial Designs was convened by WIPO and held in Geneva from June 16 to July 6, 1999.

The Diplomatic Conference adopted, on July 2, 1999, the Geneva Act of the Hague Agreement Concerning the International Registration of Industrial Designs, which was opened for signature on July 6, 1999.
