1. The Advisory Committees unanimously agreed that the issu eofen forcement of intellectual property rights was of great importance to all countries. The Committees also agreed that the World Intellectual Property Organization (WIPO) was in a particularly appropriate position togather information concerningen for rement of intellectual property rights and to coordinate activities under taken by the Committees jointly with various intergovernmental and non-governmental organizations aiming a testablishing adequate and effective enforcement systems.

- (a) TheIntern ationalBureauisinvitedtoestablishanElectronicForuminsuchaway astofacilitatetheexchangeofinformationrelatingtoenforcementissues,ascalledforby variousdelegationsinthecourseoftheJointMeetingoftheAdvisoryCommitteesfrom December18to20,2001.
  - (b) theInternationalBureauisinvitedto:
- (i) identifytheexistingneedsfortrainingandfordevelopmentofenforcement strategies;
- (ii) continueandintensifyWIPOactivitiesinfavorofdevelopingcountriesand countriesintransition,inparticulartheactivitiesoftheWIPOWorldwideAcademyandof theregionalbureaus,withregardtotraining,technicalassistanceandawarenessbuildingin thefieldofenforcement,takingintoaccountthecommentsmadeinthisresp ectbythe AdvisoryCommittees;
- $\mbox{(iii)} \ \ report on the seactivities to the next WIPO meeting on enforcement is sues (see below).$
- (c) Asregardsthepreparationofmodelenforcementprovisionsandpractices, and the resolution of problems and difficulties, etc., in the enforcement field, the Advisory Committees:
- (i) recommended that Member States, in particular those which had not already doneso, and international, intergovernmental and non -governmental organizations in both the industrial property and the copyright fields be invited to submit comments, observations and suggestions to the International Bureau by February 28, 2002;
- (ii) requested the International Bureautoprepare, primarily on the basis of the information received from Member Stat es and international, intergovernmental and non-governmental organizations, a structured synthesis of issues concerning practices in the enforcement field, including Interneten forcement issues, and relating to the possible future work referred to in the introductory part to paragraph 1(c), which would serve as a basis for discussion at the next WIPO meeting onen forcement in 2002 (see below). That document should not be confined to legal as pects only but also include all matters raised by the governments and relevant organizations;
- $(iii) \ \ requested the International Bureautoe stablish a list of contact points on the basis of the list of participants of the meeting and subsequently extended based on additional information from governments.$
- 2. TheAdvisor yCommitteesrecommendedthatameetingonenforcementissueswitha clearlydefinedagendabeconvenedin2002andthattheWIPOGeneralAssemblydecideto convenetheAdvisoryCommitteesoronesingleAdvisoryCommitteeonEnforcementatits sessionofS eptember2002.
- 3. TheSecretariatannouncedthatthemeetingonenforcementissueswastentatively scheduledfortheweekofSeptember 9,2002.
