I. Introduction

- 1. The Joint Meeting of the Advisory Committee on Enforcement of Industrial Property Rights (ACE/IP) (Second Session) and the Advisory Committee on Management and Enforcement of Copyright and Related Rights in Global Information Networks (ACMEC) (Third Session) in December 2001, recommended that a committee or committees be established to continue discussions on issues related to the enforcement of intellectual property rights.
- 2. Pursuanttothisrecommendation,theWIPOGeneralAssembly,atitssessionheldfrom September23toOctober1,2002,approvedtheestablishmentoftheAdvisoryCommitteeon Enforcement(ACE)(documentWO/GA/28/7,paragraphs114(i)and120).TheWIPO GeneralAssemblyalso approvedtherulesof procedure and certain administrativematters concerningtheACE(documentWO/GA/28/7,paragraphs114(ii),(iii)and120).
- 3. Thisdocumentmakesreferenceto the decision staken by the General Assembly, provides additional information concerning procedural and organizational matters and makes certain proposals regarding working arrangements.

II. ProceduralandOrganizationalMatters

- 4. RulesofProedure .Atitsfirstsession,theACE/IPadoptedthesamerulesof procedureadoptedforWIPObodies,namelythe"WIPOGeneralRulesofProcedure" (PublicationNo.399(FE)Rev.3).Inaddition,theACE/IPexercisedtheoption ¹toadopttwo specialrules ofprocedurewhichwere,firstly,thatmembershipintheACE/IPbeextendedto MemberStatesoftheParisUnionthatwerenotMemberStatesofWIPO,andthatobserver statusbeextendedtoMemberStatesoftheUnitedNationsthatwerenotMemberStatesof WIPOortheParisUnionand,secondly,thattheChairandthetwoVice -Chairsshouldservea termofoneyearandwouldimmediatelybeeligibleforre -electiontotheofficesthattheyhad heldattheexpirationofthatterm. ²
- 5. The Joint Meet ingofthe ACE/IP and ACMEC decided to adopt the same rules of procedure which were adopted at the first session of the ACE/IP and to apply them *mutatis mutandis* to the ACMEC.
- 6. Asstatedinparagraphs114(iii)and120ofdocumentWO/GA/28/7,t heWIPOGeneral Assemblydecided,forthepurposeofconsistency,thattherulesofproceduredescribedabove beadopted *mutatismutandis* fortheACE.
- 7. *Membershipandobservers*. PursuanttoRules 7and8oftheWIPOGeneralRulesof Procedure,andparagraph114(iii)ofdocumentWO/GA/28/7,theDirectorGeneralhasinvited tothefirstsessionoftheCommittee,asmembers,allMemberStatesofWIPO,theParis UnionandtheBerneUnionand,asobservers,MemberStatesoftheUnitedNationsthat are notmembersofWIPOortheParisUnionortheBerneUnionandcertainintergovernmental organizationsandnon -governmentalorganizationsaccreditedwithobserverstatusatWIPO. Inaddition,oneintergovernmentalorganizationandanumberofnon -governmental organizationswereinvitedas *adhoc* observers.
- <u>8.</u> Inorderto make theworkoftheCommitteemoreefficientandtofacilitate communicationand contact with therelevantstakeholdersatthenational andinternational levels,MemberStatesofWIPOmightfinditadvantageoustoconsultagencieswhichare responsiblefortheenforcementofindustrialpropertyrightsandcopyrightandrelatedrights and,if possible,toincluderepresentatives ofthoseagenciesintheirrespectivedelegations
- 9. Fundingforparticipationofgovernmentofficials .Asstatedinparagraphs114(iii) and 120ofdocumentWO/GA/28/7 and paragraph14ofdocument WO/GA/28/4,theWIPO GeneralAssembly decided thatfundingbemadeavailabletofacilitatetheparticipationof representativesofdevelopingcountriesandofcertaincountriesinEuropeandAsia .
- 10. *Languages*. Simultaneousinterp retationinsessionsoftheCommitteewillbeprovided from and into English, Arabic, Chinese, French, Spanish and Russian. The working documents for sessions of the Committee will be prepared in English, French and Spanish

11. Sessions. Subject to budget ary allocations, it is proposed that the Committee meet once a year. For each session of the Committee, the Chairwould provide a summary of the conclusions of that session.

III. TheRoleoftheCommitteeandtheScopeofitsActivites

- 12. Mandate. Asprovidedinparagraphs114(ii)and120ofdocumentWO/GA/28/7,the mandateoftheCommitteeinthefieldofenforcementexcludesnormsettingandislimitedto technicalassistanceandcoordination. TheCommittee will focusonthefollowingobjectives: coordinatingwithcertainorganizationsandtheprivatesectortocombatcounterfeitingand piracyactivities; publiceducation; assistance; coordinationtoundertakenational and regional training programs for all relevants takeholders and exchange of information on enforcement is suesthrough the establishment of an Electronic Forum.
- ScopeofActivities .ItisproposedthattheCommitteewouldcontinueandfurther developtheworkcarriedo utbytheACE/IP,ACMECandtheConsultationMeetingon Enforcement, which was held in Geneva from September 11 to 13,2002, taking into account theobjectives described in paragraph 1 2ofthisdocument.Forthispurpose,it thatheCommittee identifythemesofparticularinterestforfurtherexamination and discussionatfuturemeetings. Suchthemescould, for example, include the role of the judicial authorities in the field of enforcement of intellectual property rights; the development of nationalstrategiesinordertorenderenforcementofintellectualpropertyrightsmore effective; assistance by the private sector to enforce mentagencies in the identification of the private sector to the private sector of the private seccounterfeitandpiratedgoods,training,and activities relating to education and awareness building; the socio -economic impactof counterfeiting and piracy; and the implementation of procedures and mechanisms for appropriate and effective border measures. A number of considered for further discussion, may be derived from otherthemes, which could be documentsWIPO/ACE /1/3and4andtheannexesthereto. The discussions on these themes couldbeprecededbypresentationsmadebystakeholderswithaparticularexperienceinthe respectivefieldofac tivity.

- (ii) considertheproposal contained in paragraph 1 3 on the scope of the activities of the Committee.
