MATTERSCONCERNINGT HEELECTRONICEXCHAN GEOFINFORMATION

DocumentpreparedbytheSecretariat

- 1. AtthesessionoftheAssembliesoftheMemberStatesofWIPO,heldinGenevafrom September 23toOctober1,2002,theGeneralAssemblyestablishedasingleAdvisory CommitteeonEnforcement,inchargeof globalenforcementissues,coveringbothindustrial propertyandcopyrightandrelatedrights. ThemandateoftheCommittee, which excludes norm-settingactivities, was limited to technical assistance and coordination. The Committee has the following ob jectives: coordinating with certain organizations and the private sector to combat counterfeiting and piracy; publiced ucation; assistance; coordination to undertake national and regional training programs for all relevants takeholders and exchange of information on enforcement is suesthrough the establishment of an Electronic Forum.
- 2. SubsequenttothesessionoftheAssembliesoftheMemberStatesofWIPO,the DirectorGeneralofWIPOestablishedtheEnforcementandSpecialProjectsDivisi ontoserve asafocalpointforenforcementactivitiesintheInternationalBureau. TheDivisionactively cooperateswiththecompetentauthoritiesinMemberStates ,intergovernmentalorganizations and non-governmentalor ganizationsintheareaofenforcement.Furthermore,itplaysa pivotalroleinthecoordinationofenforcementactivitieswithintheInternationalBureau. Beyondtheseandotheractivities, ¹theEnforcementandSpecialProjectsDivisionalso

providesad ministrativesupportforthemaintenanceoftheElectronicForum, which is of particular importance for the subject matter of this document.

- 3. PursuanttothesaiddecisionoftheWIPOGeneralAssembly,andinaccordancewith therecommendation bytheConsultationMeetingonEnforcement,heldinGenevafrom September11to13,2002, anElectronicForumonIntellectualPropertyEnforcementIssues andStrategies (hereinreferredtoas"theElectronicForum")wasestablishedinJanuary 2003. TheElectronicForum ²iscurrentlyopentoregisteredparticipantsfromallMemberStatesand observers,including *adhoc* observers,totheAdvisoryCommitteeonEnforcement. At presentthisincludes168representativesof91MemberStates,17representativesof 11 intergovernmentalorganizationsand35representativesof28non -governmental organizations. Thelistofregisteredparticipantsisprovidedinthetable attached tothis document.
- 4. TheElectronicForumhasbeenestablishedon theWIPOwebsite.Asdescribedin documentWIPO/CME/INF/1Rev. "ElectronicExchangeofInformation: Establishment of an Electronic Forum, "the Electronic Forum, inits current form, has been designed to serve threemainpurposes. First, as in the case of similar for umsof the Standing Committee on the Law of Patents (SCP) and the Standing Committee on the Law of Trademarks,Industrial Designs and Geographical Indications (SCT), the Electronic Forumal lows for preliminary versionsofdraftworkingdocumentstobemadeavailabletoregisteredparticipantsand provides for the electronic receipt of comments thereon. Second ,itfacilitatesthecollection ofinformationrelated towork to be undertaken by the Secretariat, through providing for the electronic distribution of requests for information and receipt of responses thereto. Third, it provides a forum where by particip ant scan share information as to their respective national experiences in the field of enforcement.
- 5. TheregistrationproceduresandconditionsofuseoftheElectronicForum ³ are similar to those of the SCP and SCTF or um sand include, in particular, conditions relating to the type of information to be posted on the ElectronicForum and its accessibility to all participants. However, these procedures were adopted prior to the establishment of the Advisory

PursuanttotheproposalbytheConsultationMeetingofEnforcement,toencourageall membersandobserverstosub mitfurtherinformationpertainingto, *interalia*, theissuesraised indocumentsWIPO/CME/2Rev.and3,theSecretariatofWIPOonceagaininvited Member Statesandobserverstorespondtothequestionnaire(see CircularlettersNos.6815and6816, dated July 17, 2001. Additionalinvitationswithfurtherextensionsofthedeadlineweresentto theparticipantsoftheIPEISElectronicForum.) AlthoughtheSecretariatofWIPOreceived another15responsesfrom13MemberStatesand two non-governmentalor ganizationstoits renewedrequestforinformation,theadditionalinformationwasnotconsideredtobesufficient topreparesubstantiveupdatesofdocumentsWIPO/CME/2Rev.and3 (see documents WIPO/ACE/1/3and4).

Alternativemethodsofparticipation, suchasfacsimiletransmission or postare provided for those who wish to register for, and participate in, the Electronic Forum, but do not have access to the Internet and/or electronic mail.

- 6. InlightofthesubsequentdecisionbytheGeneralAssemblyonthemandateofthe AdvisoryCommitteeonEnforcement,themainpurposeoftheEl ectronicForumhaschanged. TakingdueaccountofthemandateoftheAdvisoryCommitteeonEnforcement,mentionedin paragraph1ofthisdocument,themostimportantfunctionoftheElectronicForumisto provideameanstocollect,communicate,shareandiscussrelevantinformationpertainingto globalenforcementissues.Forthisreason,abroaderparticipationofallrelevantstakeholders isdesirable.
- Inordertofacilitateparticipationbyallrelevantstakeholders, the 7. Secretariathad alreadysuggested,inparagraph12ofdocumentWO/ GA/28/4on "MattersConcerningthe" StatusoftheAdvisoryCommitteeonEnforcement," asafirststep,thatMemberStatesmay wishtoconsiderincludingintheirrespectivedelegationsotherconcern edagencies responsible for the enforcement of industrial property rights and copyright and related rights. This would also facilitate contact with the relevant stakeholders at the national and the internationallevels. Taking into account the greatnumberofenforcementagenciesin MemberStatesandthefactthatcoordinationhasbeenidentifiedasoneofthedifficultiesin the field of enforcement, it is contended that broader participation in the Electronic Forumwouldhelptorealizethefillpotentialthereof.
- 8. Inlightoftheabove,andinaccordancewithparagraph(i)oftheannexto document WIPO/CME/INF/1Rev.,whichreads:"[T]heseprocedurewillbereviewedat futuremeetings,onthebasisofexperience,andinlighto fparticularneedsanddevelopments inthefieldofenforcement,"itisrecommendedthattheprocedurespertainingtoparticipation intheElectronicForumbereviewed,takingintoaccountthedecisionoftheGeneral AssemblythatthemandateoftheCommit teewouldexcludenorm -settingactivities,butthat thefocuswillbe, *interalia*,ontheexchangeofinformationonenforcementissuesthrough theElectronicForum.Inthiscontext,theSecretariatofWIPOwouldliketoproposethe following:
- (a) Preliminarydraftworkingdocumentswouldnotbemadeavailableonthe ElectronicForumforcomments,butworkingdocumentswouldbepostedontheForumin theirfinalform. ⁵
- (b) ParticipationintheElectronicForumwouldnolongerberestricted.In accordancewiththeobjectiveofpromotingtheexchangeofinformationonglobal enforcementissuesthroughtheElectronicForum,asdecidedbytheWIPOGeneral Assembly,thiswouldfacilitateaccessto,andparticipationin,theElectronicForumand engenderabro aderdiscussionbyinterestedpartiesandstakeholdersofenforcementissues.
- (c) Registrationwouldnolongerberequiredasapre -conditionforaccesstothe ElectronicForum. However, registration would result in the participant being notified of new items posted on the ElectronicForum.

Thesedocuments will also be distrib uted in paper form in the usual manner to all Member States and observers of the Advisory Committee on Enforcement.

- (d) TheWIPOwebsitewouldprovidealinktotheElectronicForum.

 9. TheEnforcementandSpecialProjectsDivisionwouldcontinuetoadministerand monitortheElectronicForumandreservestherighttode cide,onacase -by-casebasis, whetherinformationshouldbeexcludedfrompublicationinwholeorinpartoronly publishedinanamendedorneutralform.Althoughregistrationwouldnolongerbea pre-requisitetoparticipationintheForum,theEnforc ementandSpecialProjectsDivision wouldcontinuetomaintainalistofregisteredparticipantsandpersonsonthelistwouldbe alerted,whereappropriate,wheneverinformationispostedontheElectronicForum.
- 10. Statesareencouragedtoin viteofficialsfromenforcementagenciesandintellectual propertyofficesintheirrespectivecountriestoregisterwiththeElectronicForum.Anactive participationintheinformationexchangebyrepresentativesofMemberStatesandobservers, byright holdersandbyotherpersonsinterestedintheenforcementofintellectualproperty rightswouldbeappreciated.

11. The Advisory Committee on Enforcement is invited to consider the proposal scontained in paragraph 8 of this document.
