- · an indication of origin
- and a quality mark

medium-sized town

 Germany, North Rhine-Westphalia

• population: 165,000

area: about 90 km<sup>2</sup>





## Development of the Cutting Industry

- early middle ages: finding and mining of iron ore energy sources: wood, power of water
- 13th century: distribution to other countries
- 1571: "Me fecit Solingen"
- after 1648: changing of the product range





## Problems of Piracy

- deceit and fraud at the consumer
- vast economic demage at the manufacturers and honest dealers
- destruction of the name's image and reputation
- final consequence:
   loss of companies and jobs



## Protection of "Solingen"

- in <u>Germany</u>:
  - Decree for the Protection of the Name Solingen in connexion with trademark legislation:
    - manufacturing within the industrial area of Solingen
    - conformance with a certain quality standard
- in other countries:
  - partly: bilateral agreements
  - regulations against unfair competition



## Prosecution in Germany

- civil actions
  - providing of evidence(e.g.investigator/consumer/competitors)
  - examination by expert
  - cease and desist letter/demand of discontinuance
  - if necessary: filing a lawsuit
- criminal procedures
  - in serious case:
     complaint to the public prosecuter





## Prosecution in Other Countries

- problem:
  - expensive actions and uncertain outcome
- objections against trademark registrations of third persons
- registration of collective marks or certification marks in our own name
- application for actions by the customs authorities



## Conclusion

- Famous indications are objects of value! They save the regional economy and protect jobs!
