Inmy letter of July 5, 2002, Ihad expressed my desire to have the Canadian IntellectualPropertyOffice(CIPO)consideredforapprovalfromtheappropriatebodiesoftheWorld IntellectualPropertyOrganizationfostatusasanInternationalSearchingAuthority(ISA) and as an International Preliminary Examining Authority (IPEA) under the Patent CooperationTreaty(PCT).

Inadditiontotheletter, adetailed submission in support of our request was enclosed, and thesetwodocumentswerereproducedasanAnnextodocumentPCT/CTC/20/2.Inparagraph 33 of the submission CIPO stated that while it currently possesses or has access to anextensivenumberofpatentrelateddocuments, there exists a limited number of docume which form part of the minimum documentation required under Rule 34 of the PCT but which the product of the parenotpresentlyaccessiblebyCanadianpatentexaminers.

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Tofurtherelaborateuponthispoint, CIPOhasprepared the attached table which indicates the type, ye arandcountryorregional office of origin of the missing documents and an approximation of the volumes. I would ask that you include this table as an addendum to documentPCT/CTC/20/2.
