#### Introduction

1. Thisdocumentcontainsaproposalforanamendmentof the Schedule of Feesannexed to the Regulation sunder the Patent Cooperation Treaty (PCT) and proposal sform of the Administrative Instruction sunder the PCT. The proposal sconcern the granting of a feered uction in relation to international application sfile din electronic form in accordance with Part 7 and Annex Fofthe Administrative Instruction sunder the PCT.

#### FeeReduction for International Applications Filed in Electronic Form

- 2. FollowingthecomingintoeffectonJanu ary7,2002,ofnewPart7andnewAnnex Fof theAdministrativeInstructionscontaining,respectively,thelegalframeworkandtechnical standardnecessarytoenabletheimplementationofelectronicfilingandprocessingof internationalapplicationsunde rthePCT,asprovidedforbyRule 89bis.1,anyreceiving Officehavingthenecessarytechnicalsystemsinplaceisabletodecidetoacceptthefilingof internationalapplicationsinelectronicforminaccordancewithPart7andAnnexF.The receivingO fficemust,undertheprovisionsofSection710,notifytheInternationalBureauof itsrequirements,andanysuchnotificationmustthenbepromptlypublishedbythe InternationalBureauinthePCTGazette.
- 3. WhilenoreceivingOfficehas yetmadesuchanotification, and it is therefore not yet possible for international applications to be filed in electronic form with any receiving Office pursuant to the new provisions, it is expected that certain receiving Offices will so on (possibly as early as October of this year) make such an otification and that it will therefore so on be possible for international applications to be filed in electronic form with such receiving Offices.
- 4. Inthiscontext, it is proposed that applicants should be given an incentive, in the form of a feered uction, to file international applications in electronic form, at least of the same amount as is the case to day in respect of an international application containing the request in the PCT-EASY format filed with a PCT-EASY diskette. At the same time, noting the important role the PCT-EASY software will continue to play for quite sometime to come, the current feered uction applicable to PCT-EASY filings should not be eliminated but should continue to be granted as an incentive for applicant stouse that software.

- 6. Itisthereforeproposedtoamenditem4oftheScheduleofFeesandtomodifythe AdministrativeInstructionssoastoapplyafeereductionofthesameamountasthat applicableinthecontextofPCT -EASYalsotointernationalapplicationsinelectronicform filedwithareceivingOfficewhichhasnotifiedtheInternationalBureauunderSe ction710 thatitispreparedtoreceiveinternationalapplicationsinelectronicform.
- 7. The proposed amendments of the Schedule of Feesannexed to the Regulations and modifications of the Administrative Instructions are contained, respect ively, in Annexes I and II to this document.
- $8. \quad The proposed modifications of the Administrative Instructions are included in this document (as Annex II) for the purposes of consultation under Rule 89.2(b).$

#### PCT-SAFEPilotProject

- 9. Inthiscontext, it should be noted that the International Bureau intends to apply a fee reduction of the same amount as that applicable in the context of PCT -EASY also to international applications filed, during the PCT -SAFE (Secure Applications Filed Electronically) Pilot Project, with the International Bureau as receiving Office.
- 10. Itisrecalledthat,underthePCT -SAFEProject(formerlyknownasthePCTElectronic FilingProject),electronicfilingsoftwareisbeingdevelopedb ytheInternationalBureauasan extensionofthePCT -EASYsoftwareandwillbemadeavailable,in2003,toapplicantsand receivingOffices.TheobjectiveofthePCT -SAFEPilotProjectistotaketheelectronicfiling legalframeworkandthetechnicalst andard(seePart7andAnnexF)aswellasassociated computerdevelopmentsthroughaproof -of-conceptprocess;itwillenablefurther developmentofthesoftwareandoperationalproceduresinpreparationforfull implementationofelectronicfilingin20 03.
- 11. The PCT SAFE Pilot Project is scheduled to last from October 2002 to March 2003. During that period, a limited number of Pilot participants (restricted to applicants registered for participation in the Pilot Project) will have the opportunity to file, with the International Bureau as receiving Office, international applications prepared using the PCT SAFE software on paper with a parallel submission of the complete application in electronic form.
- NotingthatthePCT -SAFEPilot"system"forpreparinginternational applications using the PCT - SAFE software is an extension of the present system for preparing international applications using the PCT - EASY software, the similarities of both systems (under both systems, international applications are filed on paper together with an electronic copy of the request(PCT -EASY)andoftheentireapplication(PCT -SAFE),respectively),andthefact thattheInternationalBureauwillbenefitfromastreamlinedhandlingofinternationa applicationspreparedusingthePCT -SAFEsoftwarefiledduringthePilotProjectatleastas muchasitdoesfromPCT -EASYfilings(inparticular with regard to data capture at the International Bureau), it appears justified to apply a feered uction of t hesameamountasthat applicableinthecontextofPCT -EASYalsotoPCT -SAFEPilotparticipantsalthough, strictly speaking, international applications filed under the PCT -SAFEPilotProjectwouldneither complywiththerequirements of Section 102 bisnor withtherequirementsofproposednew Section 707(b).

#### Review of PCTFee Structure

13. Itistobenotedthatthequestionoffeereductionsforbothinternationalapplications containingtherequestinPCT -EASYformatandforinternational applicationsfiledinfully electronicform(PCT -SAFE)willhavetobe(re)examined inthecourseofpreparingthe programandbudgetofWIPOfor2004 -2005,inthecontextof thenecessarydeterminationof

the amount of the new international filing feep oposed to be introduced for international applications filed on or after January 1,2004 (see documents PCT/A/31/6 and PCT/A/31/6 Add.1) and the ensuing need for a complete review of the PCT feest ructure.

- 14. The Assembly of the PCT Union is invited:
- (i) toadopttheproposedamendmentto theScheduleofFeesannexedtothe RegulationsunderthePCTasappearingin AnnexItothisdocumentandtodecidethatit willenterintoforceonOctober17,2002,and thatitwillapplyonlyinrespec tof internationalapplicationsfiledonorafterthat date;
- (ii) tonotethattheDirectorGeneral intendstopromulgatemodificationsofthe AdministrativeInstructionsbasedonAnnexII tothisdocument,takingintoaccount consultationspursuanttoR ule89.2(b)during theAssembly'ssessionandsubsequently,with effectfromOctober 17, 2002.
