- 1. Regulation 4.8.(a) of the WIPOSt aff Regulations and Staff Rules provides that "Staff members shall be appointed by the Director General; however, appointments to post in the special category (grades D.1 and D.2) shall be made taking into account the advice of the Coordination Committee."
- 2. The Director General intends, if the Coordination Committee agrees, to appoint six staff members to grade D.1. The six staff members in question occupy key positions in the Secretariat. The duties and responsibilities of each position correspond to those for which the grade of Director is appropriate. A description of the duties of each position and brief biographical details of the staff members who occupy the positions and who are proposed for promotion to grade D.1 are set out in the following paragraphs.

Director, Division for Cooperation with certain Countries in Europeand Asia

3. The Division for Coop eration with certain Countries in Europeand Asia aims to strengthen intellectual property systems in cooperating countries and to encourage their effective use, taking into account the overall objective of the development of the national intellectual property systems of the cooperating countries concerned. The Division is involved, *interalia*, in the formulation and implementation of cooperation programs for the strengthening of intellectual property administrations and collective management

organizations; the provision of advice on compatibility of existing legislation with relevant international treaties; and consultations with governments and legislators concerning the ratification of, or accession to, WIPO - administered treaties, capacity building, in creasing public awareness of intellectual property is sues and promoting innovation in frastructure and services development.
