What are corrections?



General Information

- The WIPO carries out corrections in the following cases:
 - Errors by an Office: requested by the Office within 9 months from the date of publication
 - Errors by the WIPO: no time limit
 - Errors by an Office the correction of which would not affect the rights deriving from the international registration: any time and presented by the Office



Admissible or not?

A holder sends a correction request directly to WIPO. The error was made by the holder as he forgot to add 2 countries in the list of designations.

Do we accept this type of correction?



General Information

■ WIPO does not carry out corrections when the error is made by the holder.

- (1) Corrections

Rule 28 (1)

■ WIPO considers that there is an error in an international registration, it must correct that error *ex* officio

■ WIPO will also correct an error at the request of the holder or an Office



Rule 28 (2)

■ Notification of correction published and sent to:

- Holder or current representative
- Offices of designated Contracting Parties
- Office that requested correction



Rule 28 (3)

When an international registration is corrected: Offices of designated Contracting Parties may send a notification of provisional refusal from the date of the notification of such correction

Rule 28 (4)

■ Time limit for request of correction of an error made by an Office, the correction of which would affect the rights deriving from the international registration: 9 months from publication date



Exercise on admissibility



Question 1

- A correction request was received from a holder.
- Mistake in the list of goods and services
- The holder attached the application that they sent to the German Patent Office:

Therefore the list of goods and services should read:

- 14 Jewellery; clocks
- 18 Bags for sports; cosmetic purses; vanity cases sold empty; leisure bags; back-packs; beach bags; suitcases; travel bags; umbrellas; parasols
- 24 Towels made of textile fabrics; bath towels; fabrics made from synthetic fibres for the manufacturing of swimwear
- 25 Clothing; swimwear; beachwear; headgear for wear; footwear

Question 2

Dear Sirs,

Thank you for your e-mail.

As we already explained, the submission of the official form MM8 for the cancelation of classes 29 and 35 and some products of class 05 from contracting party China in IR XX has been a mistake attributed only to us.

We well know that we had to use form MM6 for this type of limitation, but we confused due to the fact the IR XX designated only the contracting party China

Answer: Rejected

Dear Sirs,

Yesterday, we have received phone calls from you, asking for a correction to cancel the partial cancellation of 1 August 2019, in regard to the International Registration XX.

We investigated and confirmed that the request for partial cancellation was submitted with the official form MM8, signed by the representative. It was processed in line with rule 25 of the Common Regulations and no mistake has been made by the International Bureau. As a result, a correction under rule 28 of the Common Regulations is not admissible in this case. I also sought advice from the Madrid legal department, which confirmed that we cannot do a correction.
