- An agency under the purview of The Ministry of Domestic Trade, Co-operatives and Consumerism (MDTCC) Malaysia
- Responsible for the development and administration of intellectual property rights (IPR) system in Malaysia
- The legal custodian of IP in Malaysia
- Plays an important role in promoting IP and dissemination of IP knowledge to the public



SMEs in Malaysia

- 98.5% of business establishments are Small and Medium Enterprises (SMEs)
- Unfortunately, SMEs are responsible for only 36.6% of the country's GDP
- And 17.8% of Malaysia's exports

Government Initiatives for SMEs

- SME Corp. Malaysia Central coordinating agency for development of SMEs
- PlatCom Ventures the national technology commercialisation platform committed to help inventors and entrepreneurs to achieve commercial success
- Public-Private Research Network (PPRN) initiative spearheaded by the Ministry of Education to match-make the industry and research organisations



Issues faced by SMEs

- Only 6% of SMEs are creators others are adapters and adopters
- Low level of awareness on IP
- Lack of IP promotion and understanding in Government Agencies
- Difficulty in accessing information too fragmented across the Ministries



Way Forward

- Establish Industry-Led Collaborative Networks to enhance Demand Driven Research and Private Sector Participation
- Facilitate dissemination and monitoring of Industry Related Information
- Increase IP awareness for SMEs
