## Requirements of patentability

- Lack of
  - Technical nature
  - Unity
  - No case of exemption
  - Industrial applicability
  - Novelty
  - Inventive step
  - Sufficient disclosure
  - Legal certainty of claims (clarity)
  - Additions to initial disclosure

Should be checked before prior art search

Requires prior art search



## Requirements for patentability

- Basic categories of requirements are the same in most jurisdictions (unity, novelty, inventive step, technical nature)
- Difference exist mostly in terms of exemptions, e.g.
  - US do grant business methods, software patents,...
  - DE grants new use of known compound, PK does not

- Important differences exist in case law, e.g.
  - Technical nature of software related patents
  - Inventive step
