

Track Record

- ☐ 296 Projects in the Development Pipeline
 - USD 6,9 billion of Investment
 - 12,8 million tonnes pa CO2 e GHG reduction potential
 - 3,7 MW of clean capacity
- ☐ 59 Projects Closed / USD 653 million raised
 - 516,3 MW of Installed Clean Capacity
 - 2,3 million tonnes CO2 e reduction pa
 - 109,4 GWh pa Energy Savings (EE projects)
- ☐ 15 Financing Fora
 - 621 projects identified / 210 selected / 136 showcased
 - 38 Projects Closed / USD 336,2 million raised



What makes an investment grade company?

- Business model and Value proposition
 - Project rationale (Why?)
 - For whom? What problem is addressed?
 - Why should the investor invest in this Project?
- Attractive market size and potential
 - Addressable market
 - Competition, Entry barriers and Growth potential
- □ Financially rewarding
 - Expected returns and exit options
 - Investment horizon
 - Break even time/quantity
 - Debt servicing capacity
- □ Risk identification and mitigation measures
- □ Social impact

 ☐ Active Board participation




Project Development Stages

CTI PFAN Mentoring Experience

- ☐ Typical points for improvement
 - Products/Services and Margin
 - Addressable market and pricing
 - Clearly defined revenue model
 - Clearly articulated investment ask
 - Execution capabilities and timeline
 - A sound financial model
 - Project risks and mitigation
 - An attractive exit for the investor
 - Over optimistic approach / attitude
 - Understanding working capital cycle
 - Strong technical knowledge but limited business knowledge
 - Need explicit support in understanding Investor's language
 - Little or no Investor pitching experience
