OF THE REGULATIONS UNDER THE PCT

It is proposed that Rule 28 of the Regulations under the PCT should read as follows:

[“Defects Noted by the International Bureau](#)

28.1 [Note on Certain Defects](#)

(a) If, in the opinion of the International Bureau, the international application contains any of the defects referred to in Article 14(1) (a) (i) or (ii), the International Bureau shall bring such defects to the attention of the receiving Office.

(b) If any elements of the international application do not admit of direct reproduction by photography, electrostatic processes, photo offset, and microfilming, in any number of copies, the International Bureau shall bring such defects to the attention of the receiving Office, and that Office shall proceed as provided in Article 14(1) (b) and Rule 26.”
