








Growth in PCT application filings

International applications in 2020 by country of origin



- 25% originating in China, 21% in US, 18% in Japan
- 64% from the top 3 countries, 79% from top 5 countries, 93% of filings from top 15 countries

Rule changes adopted by the PCT Assembly in October 2021 (1)

- Amendment of PCT Rules 5, 12, 13*ter*, 19.4 and 49
 - ☐ ST.26 will replace ST.25 as the standard on sequence listings
 - ☐ Complete revision of Annex C and further changes to the Administrative Instructions to be implemented
- WIPO desktop tools:
 - □ WIPO Sequence software tool (for applicants) (<u>https://www.wipo.int/standards/en/sequence/index.html</u>) to help author standard-compliant SLs, and
 - ☐ WIPO Sequence Validator tool (for offices) to verify compliance

Rule changes adopted by the PCT Assembly in October 2021 (2)

- Amendment of PCT Rule 82quater
 - ☐ "Epidemic" added as one of the emergencies listed
 - □ Express authorization for Offices to waive the requirement to provide evidence
 - □ Authorization for Offices and Authorities to extend time limits covered by Rule 82quater, in addition to excusing delays in meeting such time limits
- Planned entry into force: July 1, 2022

- Section 102(h) Administrative Instructions: flexibility for Offices to design online filing interfaces: e.g., optional online retrieval of documents instead of sending of notifications; ePCT is being developed to provide for this option
- Section 705*ter* Administrative Instructions: legal basis for permitting international applications to be converted from one electronic format (e.g., PDF) to another electronic format (XML) for further processing
