### REPORT

*Corrigendum prepared by the Secretariat*

Paragraphs 90 and 91, on page 15, in document SCIT/8/10, issued on February 27, 2004, should read as follows:

“90. The Delegation of Mozambique and the Representative of the Eurasian Patent Office requested information concerning the criteria and procedures for receiving automation assistance. The Representative of the Eurasian Patent Office was particularly concerned with the situation in the Eurasian continent pointing out that there were poor countries in that region as well as countries with economies in transition which are in need of this type of assistance from WIPO.

91. The Secretariat noted the specific request made by the Representative of the Eurasian Patent Office and would consider, in due course, providing automation assistance to IPOs upon request.”
