Background

- 1. InSeptember1998,theAssembliesoftheMemberStatesofWIPOapprovedthe establishmentofaGlobalInformationNetwork(WIPONET).TheaimofthisProject isto providethenecessaryinfrastructureandservicesforimprovedinformationexchangeamong theglobalintellectualpropertycommunity(seedocumentA/32/4,AnnexI).
- $2. \quad Following this approval, under the oversight of the Standing Committee \qquad on Information \\ Technologies (SCIT), the International Bureau (IB) developed a deployment strategy, together \\ with a Project implementation plan, which was approved by the SCIT at its fifth Plenary Session in July 2000.$
- 3. The present document contains a progress report on the implementation of the WIPONET Project.

OverallProjectStatus

4. The Project has experienced some delays in the deployment of the WIPONETKIT at the intellectual property of fices (IPOs) and in the production of an ewversion of the Gold Disk, that is, the CD -ROM containing all the pre-configured operating system and desk tops of tware, delivered together with the WIPONETKIT. This new version in corporates software updates and remove scertain deficiencies identification.

5. Afurthereightofficeshavereceivedthe WIPONETKIT ,bringingthetotalnumberof installedofficesto51.Forty -nineofficesarenowpreparingfordeployment.Someofthe pendingofficesare experiencingdifficultiesinsitepreparation,resultingindelaysin deployment.

- 6. Afurthereightofficesreceivedthe WIPONETKIT.
- 7. Onehundred andseventy -sevencircularletterssenttoOfficesalreadyconnectedtothe Internet,ascertainingtheirinterestinparticipatinginthe WIPONET Project;164affirmative repliesreceived.
- 8. Onehundredandfifty -oneFocalPointsof137diffe rentOfficesfrom106countries havebeentrained.

<u>ProjectMilestones/DeliverablesfortheNextPeriod(threemonths)</u>

9. DeliveryofthenewversionoftheGoldDisk,followedbythere -startofthedeployment oftheremaining22 offices.Fou rmore WIPONET trainingWorkshopshavealsobeen planned.

KeyIssues

- 10. IPOstimelyresponsetoWIPOcommunicationsconcerning WIPONETKIT deployment, sitepreparationandavailabilityofFocalPointsfortrainingwouldfacilitatethetimely deliveryoftheProject.
- 11. The WIPO NET Project will come to a close by the end of 2003, and will be transferred to the ITS ervices Division for routine operations. Accordingly, IPOs are advised to make all necessary efforts to facilitate the deployment of WIPO NET in their Offices by the end of 2003.
