1. InMarch1998,theAssembliesofMemberStatesofWIPOapprovedthePCT automationProjectundertheheadingof"AutomationofthePCTSystem"(seedocument A/32/5),nowcalledIMPACT(InformationManagementforthePAtentCooperationTreaty). ThepresentdocumentcontainsaprogressreportonthedevelopmentoftheIMPACTProject.

2. The Projectis experiencing some delays due to various factors that will be detailed in the following paragraphs.

3. ThemodulecalledSystematicCOR(CommunicationsOnRequest)hasbeendelivered andisinfullproduction.Indeedthedistributionofdocuments isnowbeingdonethrough SystematicCOR.TheModuleforDataReceipt(DR)withinthecommunicationsside(COR)

has been completed and the corresponding DRM odule for the International Bureau (IB) side is currently under development and its progressiso nschedule. Regarding the remaining three modules: Specific COR and IB are running slightly behind schedule, and the RO/IB module is currently on hold.

4. SystematicCOR:deliveryofsometechnicalimprovementstotheScanning/Index serverhasbeenachieved.SpecificCOR:SpecificCORrelease2.1hasbeeninstalledonthe CORproductionserver.AccesshasbeenprovidedinternallywithinPCTforparallelrun, useracceptancetesting.Loadingofallhistoricaldocumentsisnearlycomplete.

- 5. DataReceipt(COR):allthemodulesarerunningprovidingsupporttoproduction. DataReceipt(IB):release1.4wasdelivered.DevelopmentofReceiveFa xmoduleand implementationofchangerequestshasstarted.DataReceiptSystem:integrationwithIBhas beenachieved.
- 6. IB:thestatusofthedevelopmentwasthoroughlyassessedandaconclusionwas reachedthatthesoftwareneedsfurther deeptestingbeforeitcanbereleasedforuser acceptance. Asignificantamountofdevelopmentworkneedstobedoneinordertoensure that the required functionality is delivered.
- 7. RO/IB:functionalrequirementsanalysiscompleted.

<u>ProjectMilestones/DeliverablesfortheNextPeriod(threemonths)</u>

- 8. Release 2.2 of specific COR is being prepared with some important security features, needed to make the system available to the external community.
- 9. Developmentwork byIBtodeliverthefunctionalityrequiredforthefirstprocessing team –IBRelease4.TherewillbethreeiterationsofRelease4,startingwith4.0.1on December20,2002.ThoroughtestswillbeconductedbytheIBtestteamoveraperiodof 25 elapseddays,withtheusercommunitybeingfullyinvolved.Thefinaliterationof release 4.4.2isplannedfordeliverytothetestingteaminmid -March.Finalacceptanceis expectedinmidorlateApril.

KeyIssues

10. RegardingtheIBmodule, developmenthasbeenre -scheduled.Someissuesmayarise duetoresourceavailability,anddelaysinprovidingrequirementsmayretardthefull deploymentofIMPACT.Thismaynecessitateretentionoftheoldlegacysystemsfora furtherperiod.
