Background

- 1. TheFinanceDivisionlegacysystem(FINAUT)hasbeenoperationalformorethan 16 years, withits core largely unchanged since its implementation in the mid -1980s, with only minor peripheral improvements. However, over this period there have been major increases in a reast hat directly impact the numbers of financial transactions being performed by the Secretaria tas well as a demand for improved functionality on the finance systems for example in the area of financial reporting.
- 2. UndertheAdministrationIntegratedManagementSystem(AIMS),theexistingfinance system(FINAUT)andtheBudgetExpenditureTrackingSystem (BETS)reportingsystem willbereplaced,budgetmonitoringfacilitieswillbeintegratedandallexistingmanualor computer-assistedinterfaceswillbeassured,asdecidedbytheStandingCommitteeon InformationTechnologies(SCIT)initsfourthPlenarySessionandasre scopedin itsfifth PlenarySession(seedocumentsA/36/3,SCIT/4/2Annex I,SCIT/5/6and10).
- 3. The present document contains a progress report on the development of the AIMS Project.

SummaryofProgress

4. Theproject, also keeping in min dsomedel ay experienced because of certain reasons beyond control, is proceeding at a good pace and interesting a chievement shave been made. The hardware and software architectures of the project are being finalized and the Business Process Requirements are being documented indetail. Substantial progress has been made on this front within the Expenditure and General Accounting and Budgetary Control areas.

<u>ProjectMilestones/DeliverablesPlannedandAchieved(forthepastthreemonths)</u>

- 5. Afteranextensivetenderreviewprocess,involvingthemajoritymajorERPsuppliers,a contractforthepurchaseofPeopleSoftFinancialsSoftwarewassignedonSeptember6,2002, coveringsoftwarelicenses,installationservices,maintenanceandstanda rdproducttraining. TrainingonPeopleSoftstandardfunctionalitywasconductedfortheavailablemembersofthe projectteamandseveralkeyusersfromtheFinanceandBudgetdivisionsduringSeptember andOctober2002.
- 6. The People Softso ftwarehas been installed on an interim server by the ITS ervices Division. This will be moved to a more powerful server for the design phase after which the production environment will be setup by acquiring the necessary servers and storage equipment.
- 7. Arequestforproposal(RFP)hasbeenissuedforservicestoassisttheAIMSProjectin thedesignandimplementationphases. Theoffersreceivedarebeingevaluated with a view to short-listing companies whose proposals will then be evaluate dindepth to select the most suitable company.

ProjectMilestones/DeliverablesfortheNextPeriod(threemonths)

- 8. Recruitmentofinternalteammemberswillbecompletedandinternalteammembers willcompletetheirtrainingrequirements duringJanuary2003.
- 9. AsystemsintegratorwillbeselectedtohelptheAIMSprojectwiththedesignand implementationphases.Oncethesystemsintegratorcompanyisselected,ajoint comprehensivereviewandupdateoftheprojectplanwill beundertaken.Thiswillresultinto andupdatedplan,whichwillbeusedasthebaselineprojectplanforexecutionoftheproject.
- 10. Usersign -offswillbeobtainedonthedocumentationofthecurrentbusinessprocesses andrequirements and the fit -gapanalysis will be initiated.

KeyIssues

11. The AIMS team is working with Human Resources Management Division (HRMD) to follow-upon recruitment of certain key internal resources, in order to avoid delay singetting all planned internal resources, which might adversely impact the project.
