DRAFT QUESTIONNAIRE ON EXCEPTIONS AND LIMITATIONS TO PATENT RIGHTS

- At its fifteenth session, held from October 11 to 15, 2010 in Geneva, the Standing Committee on the Law of Patents (SCP) requested the Secretariat to prepare a draft questionnaire on exceptions and limitations to patent rights for consideration by Member States at the sixteenth session of the SCP to be held from May 16 to 20, 2011 (see paragraph 12(i) of document SCP/15/5). Accordingly, the present document contains in the annex a draft questionnaire on exceptions and limitations to patent rights.
- 2. This questionnaire does not intend to define the scope of the exceptions and limitations contained in international treaties, nor does it aim to assess the compliance of national or regional laws with those treaties. Its objective is to facilitate the exchange of information on exceptions and limitations provided in national and regional laws.
