HAGUE AGREEMENT CONCERNING THE INTERNATIONAL REGISTRATION OF INDUSTRIAL DESIGNS

Accession to the 1999 Act: The former Yugoslav Republic of Macedonia

- 1. On December 22, 2005, the former Yugoslav Republic of Macedonia deposited with the Director General of the World Intellectual Property Organization (WIPO) its instrument of accession to the Geneva (1999) Act of the Hague Agreement Concerning the International Registration of Industrial Designs. The 1999 Act will enter into force with respect to the former Yugoslav Republic of Macedonia on March 22, 2006.
- 2. The accession to the 1999 Act by the former Yugoslav Republic of Macedonia brings the number of Contracting Parties to this Act to 19. The total number of Contracting Parties to the Hague Agreement remains 42. A list of the Contracting Parties to the Hague Agreement, indicating the date on which Contracting Parties became bound by the 1934 Act, the 1960 Act and/or the 1999 Act, is available on WIPO's website, at the following address: www.wipo.int.
