
Country Report- Lesotho

- SINCE THE DEPLOYMENT OF IPAS, THERE HAS BEEN AN INCREASE IN THE NUMBER OF APPLICATIONS BEING PROCESSED AND TRADEMARKS BEING REGISTERED

CHALLENGES

- THERE IS A CHALLENGE OF PROCESSING APPLICATIONS IN TIME DUE TO ICT RELATED ISSUES WHICH SOMETIMES TAKES A LONG TIME TO RESOLVE.
- CULTURAL CHANGE IS AN IMPORTANT ELEMENT IN AUTOMATION PROJECTS ESPECIALLY WHEN PREVIOUSLY THE CULTURE WAS PAPER BASED.

- THE OFFICE HAS PARTICIPATED IN THE WIPO **REGIONAL TRAINING WORKSHOP ON IP DATA** VALIDATION, VERIFICATION AND EXCHANGE HELD IN VICTORIA FALLS, ZIMBABWE WHERE PARTICIPANTS WERE EQUIPPED WITH A DEEPER UNDERSTANDING OF IPAS CAPABILITIES TO ENABLE AND PROVIDE SUPPORT FOR DATA VALIDATION, VERIFICATION AND EXCHANGE AS WELL AS ADVANTAGES OF USING IPAS IN DATA VALIDATION, VERIFICATION AND EXCHANGE.
