# Search and Examination

- Search and Examination of Madrid Applications currently are only done for Classes I to 34 for goods, we do not search and Examine Service Marks until our Trademarks Bill is finalized.
- Examination of National marks is done through IPAS
- The Searches are mostly done manually.
- We use IPAS, manual registers and Romarin for searching

# Challenges

- Uploading of the Madrid Applications onto our IPAS has been one of the major challenges.
- Most of the work is done manually, digitization has not taken place yet.
- Digitization has not taken place, so most process are still manual
- Non-domestication of the Madrid Protocol



# Automation and Future Plans

- One of the key immediate future plans is Automation, and we are delighted that World Intellectual Property Organization ( WIPO) has since indicated that they may help with this important task.
- Recently, a Madrid Desk was created in order to handle both the current situation and also the future designations.
