RYO FUNAKOSHI

Mr. Ryo Funakoshi, who is deputy director and Patent Examiner, joined the Japan Patent Office in April, 2001 as Assistant Patent Examiner. His field of patent examination is electronic technology, regarding information storage such as DVD, Blue-Ray and HDD (G11B) and electric circuit such as semiconductor (H03K). Furthermore, he was engaged in analysing patent statistics from 2010 to 2013 as analyst in the OECD. As a result of this experience, he is well acquainted with IP statistics and dissemination of IP information.
