1 – Facilitating technology transfer

Laws and Regulation

- ▶ Law on Patent, Utility Model Certificates and Industrial Designs was promulgated in 2003
- ▶ Regulation on procedure of granting of Patent and Utility Model Certificates (Prakas) was signed in 2006





Objective of the Law is:

- to encourage innovation, scientific and technological research and development;
- to stimulate and promote internal and external commerce and investment;
- *to promote the transfer of technology to the country in order to facilitate industrial activity and the development of the economy;*
- to provide protection for industrial rights and to combat the infringement thereof , as well as illegal business practices.

2-Management IP Assets

- ▶ Three institutions manage IPR:
 - ▶ – **Ministry of Industry and Handicraft**
 - ▶ Patent, Utility Model, Industrial Design, Layout
 - ▶ Design of Integrated circuit and New Plant Variety
 - ▶ (in cooperation with Ministry of Agriculture and Fishery).
 - ▶ – **Ministry of Commerce**
 - ▶ Trademark, Trade name, Geographical
 - ▶ Indication, Trade secret
 - ▶ – **Ministry of Culture and Fine Art.**
 - ▶ Copyright, Related Right



2-Management IP Assets (cont.)

National Committee on Intellectual Property
There are 14 institutions are members of
Committee:

Ministry of Industry and Handicraft, Ministry of Culture and Fine Arts; Ministry of Information; Ministry of Telecommunication; Ministry of Health; Ministry of Agriculture, Forest and Fishery; Ministry of Justice; Ministry of Interior; Ministry of Economy and Finance; Ministry of Environment; Council of Ministers; Ministry of Education; Ministry of Tourism and Camcontrol.



2-Management IP Assets (cont.)

- ▶ Duty of Committee are:
 - ▶ to work together in discussing the draft law concerning IP before submitting to the Council of Ministers.
 - ▶ To draft to National Strategy on IP
 - ▶ To look for International Cooperation in the field of IP.
 - ▶ To promote IP Activities in organizing seminars, workshop on IPR
