Role and Function

DTI was tasked with the role and functions secretariat for the MOST on the development and macro management of policies and strategies in the promotion of technology and innovation with the role and function as follows:

- -Study of national policies and strategy on T&I
- -Formulate legislation on management of T&I
- -Promote research on T&I
- Provide services on T&I
- Act as central coordination body with line ministries and monitoring of T&I activities
- Promote technology transfer, application and creation of T&I.

National Strategy on ST Development:

• The strategy is determined a direction development of STI from now to 2020 and a vision up to 2030.

- To develop STI system of Lao PDR's basically lifting from least developed status by 2020.
- Create factor to establish the national innovation system and advantage-modernization.
- Apply STI into incentive development of the country.

- The Strategy consist of 6 Action Plans:
- (1) Dissemination, create awareness on STI,
- (2) Improvement of the organization, systematization of management mechanism on STI's activities,
- (3)HRD,
- (4) Apply R&D in priority area and sectors (IT, Biotech, Renewable and new material, Machinery and automation technology)
- (5) Provide ST services for society and people in remote areas, and
- (6) Cooperation with international

III. Vision and Mission

Vision:

Using technology and innovation to promote production, business and services in widely and nationally 2020.

Mission:

To formulate and implement national policies, strategies, carryout technology assessment, technology statistic data, promote and develop innovation, human resources development and services for enhancing national economic and social development effectively.

- 1. Institutions responsible for technology transfer and innovation management are lack of experiences and skill.
- 2. Research activities and applies technology.
- 3. Networking or linkage among public and private sectors.
- 4. Infrastructure on R&D
- 5. Limitation of funds to support activities,
- 6. Disseminate the knowledge experiences and best practice on TT.

Challenges:

To harmonize with regional and international especially to join AEC in the year 2015 and in the global market with the high competition on trade and economic, Lao PDR has to use those opportunities to adopt technology transfer and exchanging advantage and modern STI but there are some challenges:

- -Absence of specific regulation on TT
- Competent Human Resources and research capacity
- Research capacity and technological and Innovation performance.
- -The Gaps between Private and Public sectors,

- -Lack of infrastructure and facilities for production, trade and services.
- Business sectors have limited knowledge and awareness on harmonization of economic with regional and international.
