

Statistics on Madrid Protocol Applications



Statistics for 2015 at the JPO


➤ The number of Madrid Protocol applications that the JPO accepted as Office of Origin was approx. 2,157 (yoy 7.9% ↑).

The number of notifications of designation received by the JPO as Designated Office was approx. 15,984 (yoy 26.1% [†]).






- Terms of designated goods and services accepted by both the JPO and WIPO





Reducing Irregularity Notices


Number of applicants (filing with JPO) receiving irregularity notices from the WIPO

- JPO staff transfer to different division every 2 or 3 years (Job rotations)
- Recently, some of staffs experience both "office of origin" and "Designated Office".
- Newly assigned staff receives internal training by their supervisor.
