DISTRIBUTION OF TASKS EMANATING FROM  
THE RECOMMENDATIONS OF THE ADVANCED IPC SEMINAR

AD HOC IPC REFORM WORKING GROUP

Tasks Relating to the IPC General Structure and Principles

1. Elaborate long-term goals and a strategic plan for the development of the IPC. (United Kingdom)\*
2. Reconsider the IPC revision policy.
3. Consider the introduction of electronic data illustrating the contents of IPC entries: examples of patent documents, detailed notes and classification definitions, where appropriate, more exemplifying technical terms. (United States of America)
4. Consider the elaboration of rules for multiple classification in the IPC, for example, in areas covered by the last place rule, in function-orientated versus application areas, and investigate possible bearing of such rules on general principles of classifying disclosed in the Guide to the IPC. (Discussion paper from Japan and consolidating comments)
5. Review the hybrid systems in the IPC. (International Bureau)
6. Study factors influencing an insufficient level of the consistency in the application of the IPC and elaborate measures for increasing the consistency. (United States of America)

Tasks Relating to the Revision Period, the Revision Procedure and Implementation of the Results of the Revision

7. Determine the most appropriate duration of revision cycles.
8. Study the possibility of cooperation between offices in the reclassification of backlog patent files, including its outsourcing to external contractors. (European Patent Office)
9. Reconsider the criteria for accepting new revision requests and elaborate a system of priorities for revision proposals.

Task Relating to Training in the Use of the IPC

10. Develop a general question and answer pamphlet on the application of the IPC. (United States of America)

INTERNATIONAL BUREAU

Tasks Relating to the Implementation of the Results of the Revision

11. Establish a close cooperation between the Committee and the Standing Committee on Information Technologies.
12. Study automated classification and indexing tools and conduct pilot projects on their use, in particular for the reclassification of backlog patent files.

Task Relating to Training in the Use of the IPC

13. Improve IPC training by providing modern training techniques, for example, computer-based and Internet training tools, involving, in particular, enhanced support for developing countries in the use of the IPC.
