IPC REFORM IMPLEMENTATION PLAN

Document prepared by the Secretariat

- 1. At its thirty-fourth session, held in February 2004, the Committee of Experts adopted the updated IPC reform implementation plan (see Annex VIII to document IPC/CE/34/10). Following this session, further updates to the IPC reform implementation plan were made by the International Bureau. These updates relate partly to the inclusion in the plan of IPC reform tasks completed at early stages of the reform in order to provide a comprehensive list of the reform tasks and, partly, to the inclusion in the work program of the IPC Revision Working Group of new tasks relating to the implementation of the reform results in the IPC, as agreed by the Committee of Experts (see document IPC/CE/34/10, paragraph 47).
- 2. The IPC reform implementation plan, as updated by the International Bureau, is given in the Annex to this document.
 - 3. The Committee of Experts is invited to consider the IPC reform implementation plan.

ANNEX

IPC REFORM IMPLEMENTATION PLAN

prepared by the Secretariat

- 1. The Implementation Plan covers the years 2000-2005. The timing takes account of the requirements of the Strasbourg Agreement, according to which amendments to the Classification shall be notified to the competent authorities of the IPC Union six months before their entering into force. Given that the next edition of the IPC enters into force on January 1, 2006, it should be published by July 1, 2005, and last amendments to the current edition should be adopted by the Committee of Experts in early 2005.
- 2. The Plan indicates timelines and milestones with regard to major activities which are necessary for carrying out IPC reform. Those activities could be divided in two parts, namely activities relating to the elaboration of IPC reform tasks, which were in the responsibility of the ad hoc IPC Reform Working Group (IPC/REF), the Committee of Experts (IPC/CE) and the International Bureau (IB), and activities relating to the realization of the reform results in the IPC itself, which is in the responsibility of the IPC Revision Working Group (IPC/WG). The Implementation Plan also covers the IPC revision program carried out by the IPC/WG.
- 3. The Plan of elaboration of IPC reform tasks is shown in the Table 1, below.
