ARTICLE1 BIS

Article1bis Definitions¹

ForthepurposesofthisTreaty, "broadcasting" meansthetransmissionbywireorover theair, including by cable or satellite, for public reception of sounds or of images and sounds or of the representations thereof; transmission of encrypted signals is "broadcasting" where the means for decrypting are provided to the public by the broad casting organization or with its consent. The merere transmission by cable of broad casts of abroad cast ingorganization, transmissions on computer networks, or the making available of fix ations of broad casts as set out in Article 7, shall not constitute broad casting. However, the simultaneous and unchanged retransmission on computer networks of its broad cast sty abroad casting organization is granted the protection provided under this Treaty, as if it were broad casting.
