## For Whom

- People who are blind
- People who have a visual impairment including perceptual impairment such as dyslexia
- People with a physical disability which prevents them from holding or turning the pages of a book

# WHY

To end the book/ print famine experienced by persons who are blind or who have physical impairments which prevent them from having access to print material.

Spinoff--to advance national proclamations about equity of access and the human rights of the disabled—what does

-Jamaica Charter of Fundamental Rights and Freedoms (2011) the right to seek, receive, distribute or disseminate information, opinions and ideas through any media;

## HOW & WHAT

- Creation of an accessible format from an inaccessible format. Accessible format meaning " access as feasibly and comfortably as for a person without visual impairment or other print disability" Braille, large print, electronic format
- Born –accessible format
- Published Literary and artistic works in the form of text, notation or illustration
- E newspapers, magazines, comics, webpages

#### **Authorized Entities**


Any such non-profit entity designated as an authorized entity.

- Creation

  - Other authorized entities
- Authentication of beneficiaries
- Distribution of accessible resources
- Ensuring Intellectual Freedom and Privacy
- Institutionalize the exemptions and monitor for adherence
