

- B. Purely legal challenges
 - 1. Main points licences should contain

Rights & Conditions, Liability, Third party rights, Compatibility, Applicable law, and Definitions. Other clauses may regulate Warranties, usually with a disclaimer of liability, Modifications (possible or not), Endorsement (or not), Privacy, Right to image (if any), Security, Personal data, Fees and Contact details.
