Rules of **ownership** – authors, employers, government.
Related rights – maker of sound recording/film, performer, broadcaster

Individual enforcement, negotiation of terms of use contracts. Often rights transferred to agent, publisher, distributor, guild, etc

Mass uses of copyright materials (eg broadcasting, photocopying, etc) and statutory (compulsory) licences for equitable remuneration - through collecting societies (CMOs)

### CMOs – documentation and distribution

- CMOs responsible for membership, documenting local AND international works and publishing agreements as well as licensing and distribution
- Investment in systems to capture and maintain data, research, resolve counterclaims - CMOs = trusted 3<sup>rd</sup> parties
- Reciprocal representation agreements subject to CISAC
   Professional Rules, Binding Obligations and Best Practices

   including requirements to use international standards, tools
   and formats developed by CISAC.
- For Musical Works CIS Project commenced 1994 Technical standards, International Standard Identifiers, Tools and common data exchange formats
- 2005 GDDN Global Documentation and Distribution Network – virtual (distributed) database





- Audio-visual index 2.2m productions 2.82 alternative titles

- International Standard Audio-visual Number ISAN – with AGICOA
- Standard data formats, xml reporting and sales reports DDEX









### CMOs – documentation and distribution

- International Documentation on Audiovisual works (IDA) index is an international centralized database facilitating the identification of audiovisual works and rights holders.
- IDA supports:
- The standardization of data
- A unique codification of audiovisual works
- The identification of local versions of an original work
- The identification of right owners by country and society (IPI)
- 53 member societies actively working with IDA. In 2016, more than 1.5 million works were registered in the IDA database.



### CMOs – documentation and distribution

- IMAGES + RIGHTS database
- ONLINEART (2002) now 16 CISAC societies
- 2012 services agreement -Copyright Agency (Australia – Reprographic) and Viscopy – Visual arts Australia NZ.


1997 – Operational Alliance between APRA and AMCOS to build CMS – mechanical, performing and print (reprography).



#### Drivers for back office consolidation

- Economies of scale shared documentation/distribution resources, accuracy, expense deductions
- Move from national licensing + exclusive rights → Disaggregated multi-territory digital licensing
- US non exclusive rights, Consent decrees,
- EC Recommendations 2005, Directive 2016
- Claimed content environment mandates, rights and agreements. Timing of digital releases and registrations.
- Big data. APRA Radio census analysis 30m lines, av cue sheets showing use of music. Digital trillions of lines
- Global Repertoire Database GRD project CISAC and ICMP, International Music Registry IMR WIPO and IFPI


