- 4. The content of these activities are driven by the work program and discussions which take place at the Advisory Committee on Enforcement.









New WIPO Teaching Materials on Respect for Copyright

WIPO commissioned teaching materials on respect for copyright, with the aid of funds provided by the Ministry of Culture, Sports and Tourism of the Republic of Korea. The resources consist of five sets of teaching materials covering the 10-15 age range. The materials comprise attractive, accessible learning activities intended to raise young people's awareness about copyright. Teachers' notes accompany each set of resources. The materials can be used to explore a range of contemporary social, legal and moral issues relating to IP and the digital world. The materials can be made available upon request and work is now beginning to create an interactive, online version of the materials.
