

Growing Demand for Work Sharing




- ✓ The number of patent applications in the world is increasing along with the globalization of business.
- ✓ In particular, the number of applications filed in multiple offices is significantly increasing.
- ✓ <u>Duplicate work among individual patent offices is also on the rise.</u>


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The Scheme of Patent Prosecution Highway



PPH is a framework in which an application determined to be patentable in the Office of Earlier Examination is eligible to have <u>an accelerated examination</u> in the Office of Later Examination with a simple procedure upon an applicant's request



Merits of PPH: High Speed, High Predictability, Cost Saving



Reduction in Number of Office Actions










Number of applications for the PPH & PCT-PPH (in the world)



Number of PPH request




Global PPH (GPPH)



- In order to further improve the PPH system by enhancing its attractiveness to applicants, Global PPH Pilot commenced on 6 January 2014.
- There are 17 IP Offices currently participating in the Program.


Under the GPPH Pilot, a request for accelerated examination can be made at any
participating office based on work products, including PCT work products, from
any one of the participating offices.



IP5 PPH Initiative



- IP5 PPH pilot program commenced on January 6, 2014 for a period of 3 years.
- Under the program, applicants whose patent claims have been found to be patentable by one office may ask for accelerated processing of their corresponding applications pending before the other IP5 offices.




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Development of Dossier Sharing Systems

- ✓ One Portal Dossier: OPD
- ✓ Established in 2013








Examiner Exchange Program

- 2. Learning useful tools for examiners themselves
- 3. Fostering mutual trust in "work results" of the other offices



Maximize mutual exploitation of search/examination results among the offices

Catalogue of Differing Practices :CDP



- Identifying the differences in patent examination practices in the Trilateral Offices
- Reference guide to allow examiners (and the public) to quickly understand the practices
- Expanded into IP5
