- 1. AtitsmeetinginSeptember 2002,theWIPOGeneralAssemblyconsideredthe membershipandcompositionoftheProgramandBudgetCommittee.TheGeneralAssembly unanimouslyelectedthefollowingStat esasmembersoftheProgramandBudgetCommittee fortheperiodSeptember 2002toSeptember 2005:Algeria,Argentina,Brazil,Bulgaria, Canada,Chile,China,CzechRepublic,Ecuador,Egypt,France,Germany,Hungary,India, Japan,Mexico,Morocco,Netherl ands,Nigeria,Oman,Pakistan,Philippines,Republicof Korea,RussianFederation,Senegal,SerbiaandMontenegro,Slovenia,SouthAfrica,Spain, SriLanka,Switzerland (*ex-officio*),Ukraine,UnitedKingdom,UnitedStatesofAmericaand Venezuela (35).
- 2. Thecomposition of 35 members of the Program and Budget Committee elected in September 2002 represented an increase in number of two members over the previous membership of the Program and Budget Committee. Inconsequence, two of the regional groups received an extrase at in their representation. This result was accepted by the other groups on the understanding that it was for the period September 2002 to September 2005, but that the membership and composition of the Program and Budget Committe ewould be reviewed again in September 2003 (seedocuments WO/GA/28/7, paragraph 14, and WO/GA/28/7 Corr.). It was further understood that, prior to September 2003, consultations would be held a mongthe various groups concerning the composition of the Program and Budget Committee, with a view to present in gaproposal for a different composition to the General Assembly in September 2003, should a green entbereached on such a proposal.

- 3. SinceSeptember2002,theChairoftheGeneralAssembly,H.E Ambassador Bernard Kessedjian(France),hasundertakenaseriesofconsultationswiththeGroupCoordinatorson thequestionofthecompositionoftheProgramandBudgetCommittee.Thoseconsultations haveledtoapositiveresultwithconsensusprevaili ngamongtheGroupCoordinatorsona proposalforanewcompositionoftheProgramandBudgetCommittee.Theconsensus proposalcontainsthefollowingelements:
- (i) the number of members of the Program and Budget Committee would be increased from 33 (the number of members prior to the election in September 2002 referred to in paragraph 1, above) to 41;
- (ii) theadditionalseatsontheProgramandBudgetCommittee(eight)wouldbe distributedamongthegroupsbyattributingoneextraseattoeachgroup, exceptforChina, whichwouldcontinuetooccupyoneseatonly,andtheAfricanandAsianGroups,eachof whichwouldbeattributedtwoextraseats:and
- (iii) thenewcomposition of 41 members would, once elected, constitute the Program and Budget Committee for the remainder of the current term, namely, from September 2003 to September 2005.
 - 4. The WIPO General Assembly is invited to note the consensus proposal of the Group Coordinators concerning the composition of the Program and Budget Committee, and to elect members of the Program and Budget Committee in accordance with that proposal, for the period from September 2003 to September 2005.
