Introduction - « Good to know »

- NO national/regional application or registration required
- It is possible to designate the applicant's Contracting Party
- NO subsequent designation
- Declarations made by the Contracting Parties to be taken into consideration



Introduction - « Good to know »

- The majority of the international applications is filed:
 - **directly** with the International Bureau (and NOT through the Offices of Contracting Parties)
 - via the *E-filing* interface



Preparation of the Filing of an International Application

- Entitlement to file an international application
- Languages
- Representation before the International Bureau of WIPO



Who can file an international application?

- Hague System = « closed » system
- Link with a Contracting Party (CP)(State of origin / Applicant's Contracting Party)
- Criteria:
- Nationality
- Domicile
- Real and effective industrial or commercial establishment
- Habitual residence (only under the 1999 Act)




Acts in force










One of the advantages of the « e-filing » → The system automatically determines the Contracting Parties that may be designated taking into account the information relating to the entitlement

Languages – General principle

- Rule 6 of the Common Regulations
- **English / French / Spanish** (since April 1, 2010)
- Languages:
- International application
- Communications
- Recording and publication



Requirements concerning the reproductions

Legal Framework

- Article 5 (1960 Act) / Article 5 (1999 Act)
- Rule 9 of the Common Regulations
- Administrative Instructions Section 401- 405

Reminder: no refusals relating to the form of the reproductions!



Requirements concerning the reproductions Common for paper and e-filing

- Industrial design <u>alone</u>
- Industrial design has to be shown against a neutral/plain background
- Technical drawings, with axes and dimensions are <u>not</u> acceptable
- Explanatory text or legends (in the reproduction) are <u>not</u> acceptable
- Edges cut at right angles



Amendments of the administrative instructions

(in force on July 1, 2014)

- Section 402: Representation of the industrial design
- Section 403: Disclaimers and matter that does not form part of the industrial design or the product in relation to which the industrial design is to be used
- Section 405: Numbering of reproductions and legends



EXAMPLES



Minimum and maximum sizes of dimensions (Section 402(b))


- The dimensions of the representation of each design <u>may</u> not exceed 16 x 16 cm;
 - for <u>all</u> reproductions
- One of the dimensions of the representation of each design <u>must be at least 3 cm</u>:


<u>Before</u> – for <u>all</u> reproductions

<u>Now</u> – at least for <u>one of</u> the reproductions


Legends (indications of views) (Sections 402(c)(ii) and 405(c))

- Legends may NOT be shown in a reproduction.
- Legends may be provided in association with the numbering of the reproduction in a specific item.

Legends (e.g., "front view", "perspective view", "enlarged view") provided in the above item will be published under INID code (55), separately from a "description (of the characteristic features of the design)".

(b) Reproductions (legends) (optional)
 Associate the number in the margin of your reproduction with the corresponding code:
 1 Perspective; 2 Front; 3 Back; 4 Top; 5 Bottom; 6 Left; 7 Right; 8 Reference; 9 Unfolded; 10 Exploded; 11 Cross-sectional;
 12 Enlarged; 00 Other (limited to 50 characters)




Legends: 7 Basic views






Legends: Some example of views



Disclaimer (Section 403(a))

- "Disclaimer" of protection for part of the industrial design may be indicated:
 - in the description (by text), and/or
 - by means of dotted lines, broken lines, or <u>coloring</u>.

Disclaimer by coloring has been accepted. The provision was modified to reflect that long-standing practice.




"The blue marked parts of designs 2 to 4 are not coming into the scope of the industrial design (disclaimer)"



Disclaimer (Section 403(b))

(b) Notwithstanding Section 402(a), matter that does not form part of the industrial design or the product in relation to which the industrial design is to be used may be shown in a reproduction if it is indicated in accordance with paragraph (1); (in force on July 1, 2014)













Representation of the industrial design

- The following shall not be accepted:
 - Accessory, person or animal;
 - Technical drawings, particularly with axes and dimensions;
 - Explanatory text or legends in the representation
- Merging should be at least 5 millimeters
- Cut at right angles
- Shown against neutral background
- Correct numbering



Deadline to response: 3 months

- 1.-2. "Logos, graphic elements"
 - 1. Logo
- 2. Surface patterns

Irregularity Letter:

The indication of the product or products, which constitute the industrial designs 1. Logos, graphic elements (please specify whether the design is logo or graphic symbol) is not appropriate. In order to remedy this irregularity, please indicate in writing the identification of the product(s), preferably by using the terms appearing in the list of goods of the International Classification Note that all the products should be listed under the same class of the International Classification.



Hybrid national system

Non-novelty examination

Class 2: clothing etc.

Class 5: textile etc.

Class 19: stationery etc.

- "Ex-Officio" novelty examination for all other classes
 - Designs in Class 32 cannot receive protection

Hybrid system in the Hague System

- Designation fee
 - Level 3 of Standard DF: Classes 2, 5, 19
 - Individual DF: all other classes
- Refusal period
 - 6 months: Classes 2, 5, 19
 - 12 months: all other classes

Related designs (Section 407)

- Indication of "principal design" in the application form
 - specifying "related designs"
 - paper form: Annex A to DM/1

- Optional element, no examination of the contents

Possible related designs: existing example



DM/082411 "Wristwatches"

New element: declaration concerning exception to lack of novelty (Section 408(c))

- "Declaration" in the application form
 - paper form: Annex B to DM/1
 - possible indication of designs concerned
- "Supporting document"
 - E-filing: uploading
 - paper form: attachment to Annex B
- Optional elements, no examination of the contents

New trend: specific views

Declaration under Rule 9(3) formal requirements as to "views"

for a set of articles:

- one view showing the whole set,
- views showing each component

for typefaces:

- view showing all the characters,
- view showing a sample sentence,
- view showing typical characters
