Cluster A: business continuity and relief measures

- ■98% staff work from home
- Electronic communication/notifications replacing postal mails
- Change of service protocol of Extracts and Certified Documents
- Excuse from failure to meet a time-limit
- Quick implementation of rules change about force majeure and mandatory indication of email addresses
- No office closure at WIPO due to the pandemic



Cluster B: electronic communication (O2O)



- Over 27,000 international applications via MeF till November 2021
- Discussions with more Offices of Origin are underway and some decisions are imminent.



Cluster B: electronic communication (O2C)

- Request for users to provide email addresses to IB
- Request email addresses in case of undelivered postal mails
- Special page of Contact Madrid/new Email Status Filter at Madrid Monitor
- Certificates provided as PDF file (hard copy available upon request)



Cluster B: electronic communication (O2C)



- IRNs without email address in the Register have decreased to 8%.
- Postal mails decreased by 53% in 2020 and 36% in 2021.




Cluster C: online services

- Madrid Application Assistant (MAA) launched in July 2020 to enable applicants to generate PDF file of new applications
- Another 4 online forms launched
- All Madrid online services integrated into WIPO's IP Portal
- ■3-month renewal reminder email launched



Cluster C: online services - MAA



- Benefits for users
 - easy navigation
 - automatic translation of G&S list
 - check G&S indications with MGS
 - Credit card payment
- Benefits for Office of Origin
 - Less chance of irregularities
 - Easy formality check









Irregularity rate for launched online forms




Cluster C: online services – online forms

To be launched:


- ■Change in Ownership: record a total or partial change in ownership (MM5 form)
- ■Cancellation: remove goods and services in respect of all the designated Contracting Parties (MM8 form)
- Correction of a recording: request that WIPO correct an error recorded in the International Register (MM21 form)




- International applications decreased by 0.6% in 2020 and rose by 15% in Jan.-Oct. 2021
- Overall service requests grew by 1.2% in 2020 and 8% in Jan. –Oct. 2021





- Overall production remained stable in 2020 despite a slight drop of international registrations.
- Overall production has grown by 7% in Jan.-Oct. 2021 with the same growth rate for international registrations.













C7. Average timeliness in transmitting requests for subsequent designations to the IB by selected offices of origin, 2019

C3. Average timeliness in transmitting international applications to the IB by selected offices of origin, 2020






Timeliness in Receiving Provisional Refusal (ex officio) from Top DCPs








■ Reviewing and updating <u>Examination Guidelines for</u> <u>Classification of Goods & Services</u>
