

Seeking protection in multiple markets





 - National of ...

- Registration / filed application (basic mark) in IP Office of entitlement (Office of Origin)

Appointment of a representative

- Details: name, address, phone, email address
- Only one representative
- Communications exclusively to the representative



Basic mark and priority

- Basic application / registration number & date
- Priority claim, if any



Certification by the Office of origin

- Certifies the receipt date
- Certifies the content of the International Application:
 - ➤ Applicant's Name/address
 - > Mark
 - > Goods/Services




Fees calculation

- Payable in Swiss francs to WIPO
- Fees composition:
 - ❖ Basic fee: 653 (black/white) or 903 (color)
 - ➤ Complementary fee: 100 per designation
 - ➤ Supplementary fee: 100 for each class beyond 3
 - Individual fees: required by some designations
 - Individual fees paid in two parts (BR + CU + JP)


