MSMEs, Innovation and IP

Relevance of the topic

- MSMEs play a positive role in the global economy as they contribute widely to innovation, trade, growth, investment and competition;
- In emerging economies MSMEs contribute on average to more than 50% of employment and 40% of GDP.
- No universal definition of MSMEs

- Limited contact between IP Offices and MSMEs
- No statistics and data on MSMEs and their use of the IP system
- Unclear correlation between IPRs and MSMEs
- Lack of awareness and knowledge among MSMEs about IPRs
