

In 2012, the media sector consisted of 7,000 establishments that generated **S\$31.4 billion** in operating receipts.

This translated to a contribution of **S\$8.4 billion** in nominal valueadded to the Singapore economy, an increase of 5.7 per cent from 2011.

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





32 countries in Europe have legislation for blocking overseas websites

28 are EU member states bound by EU copyright directive 8.3


13 countries have successfully had cases processed through the courts



Content Protection Measures: Site Blocking in Europe

Injunctions increase traffic to legal sources of content:


In May 2015, a study from Carnegie Mellon University suggests that website blocking requires persistent blocking of a number of piracy sites in order to effectively migrate pirates to legal channels.



Increase in usage of legal streaming services (such as Netflix) among the heaviest users of the major piracy sites blocked in the UK
