



# Seeking multinational patent protection: Traditional route v.s PCT route

#### The importance of IP: from the internal perspective. How is it good for the company?

- Helps you understand your innovation from new points of view: how can I improve the state of the art? How/why is our technology different? Can it be protected?
- Provides a competitive advantage and helps you communicate your innovation.
- Allows you to build a strong business model: use your IP, license your IP

#### The importance of IP: from the external perspective. How do others see it?

- Helps you with funding
  - Private investors (Venture Capital, Corporates...)
  - Public funding, competitive calls (EU, National, International...)
- Acts as a seal of quality: external, objective and exhaustive examination of your IP.
- IP management is always on the table. A PCT application shows commitment and is trusted by different parts. At the same time, gives you flexibility before you decide which markets are the most interesting for your innovation.

#### When is the right time for a PCT application?

- Need to find the right balance
  - Too early and you might find you need to change things as you keep on developing your idea.
  - Too late: competitors, publishing information...
- Advice: test your solution in a real environment to allow for changes and adjustments to the process.
