## Fourth online sharing session on Closing the Gender Gap in IP – Women and Tourism (November 15, 2022)

The World Intellectual Property Organization (WIPO) is organizing a series of sharing sessions to *Close the Gender Gap in Intellectual Property (IP)* focusing on women and IP. They are free of charge and open to participation by all. Sessions will be held in English and interpretation provided in French and Spanish.
