MyIPO not only grant patents but do provide patent information services. At the moment, there is no patent landscaping or patent mapping services.




- Patents Search laid open to public after 18 months from the priority date





#### **CHALLENGES**

- **Expertise** -- Lack of an analyst to carry out a patent-map analysis which not only requires knowledge in the art but also fundamental knowledge and experience in handling patent information, and an ability to analyze the patent information.
- Building, analyzing and mapping IP landscapes is highly complex.
- Analytical Method reliability of methods of patent mapping to apply; various methods of patent-map analysis have been developed in analyzing a large amount and types of patent data. Such an analysis involves detailed reading of individual patent documents and is time-consuming although sophisticated tools may be used.

#### **CHALLENGES**

■ **Best Practice** guides would require further research -- provides consistent practices for laypeople for the technology or others who are not familiar with patent information.

## **Awareness Program**

- 1. Intellectual Property Training Centre (IPTC) Planning and Implementation of Effective IP Education Programs
- 2. Public Relation Unit (PRO) Public-Private Partnership for Public Awareness Program, enhance IP awareness
- 3. Public Outreach and Information Dissemination to assist inventors to patent their inventions, Maintain their patent safeguard the rights of the patentee
- 4. Collaborations with Government agencies, Industries/SMEs and NGOs
- 5. Programs exhibitions, road shows and publications
