


Copyright Infrastructure Challenges

100 MILLION AI-GENERATED TRACKS HAVE BEEN CREATED BY MUSIC PLATFORM MUBERT





Standards Adoption

- Standards take time and money to adopt
 - And take specialized skills
- Business cases not necessarily clear
 - And not short term
- Simple standards are accessible
 - Identifiers
- Complex standards are not
 - Metadata, rights
- > Standards facilitate worthwhile niche solutions
 - Big global solutions remain elusive



Islands of Data

- > Problems with missing, inaccurate, obsolete data
- > Solutions tend to focus on one org at a time
- Global rights database projects failed



What Works?

- Niche solutions for targeted opportunities & pain points
- Standards should start simple
 - Growth in complexity comes from the market
- Publicly accessible and interoperable data islands
 - Opportunistic approach
 - Leads to more islands and then mergers
- Music leads the way
 - Well understood "atomic units" of licensing
